How to request copies of articles from the Library

1. British Dental Journal

Full-text articles from the BDJ portfolio (BDJ, BDJ In Practice, BDJ Team, Evidence-Based Dentistry, BDJ Open, BDJ Student) are available for BDA members to view online via the Nature website from 1999 to date.

To access these, you should first go to the main BDA website at www.bda.org and log in with your email address and password.

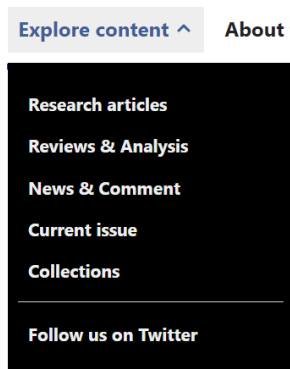

If you wish to browse previous issues of the journal, scroll down the page and click on 'View all issues'

2. E-journals from Science Direct

BDA members have full text access to 13 journals published by Elsevier through the Science Direct platform.



3. Dentistry and Oral Sciences Source (DOSS) full text database

Over 200 dental journals are indexed in the DOSS database. Most of these are available in full text, with downloadable PDFs of the articles.


Once logged in, go to <https://www.bda.org/library/journals-articles/Pages/OVID.aspx>
